

Montgomery Bar Association and Leadership Academy Sponsor 1st Reentry Day Clinic

n June 28, 2019 he Montgomery Bar Association and its Leadership Academy sponsored their first Reentry Day clinic at the Montgomery County Intermediate Unit for community members facing challenges after being released from incarceration. The event provided an on-site identification clinic, an onsite expungement clinic and an on-site resource fair which included live interviews and various organizations who provide assistance with housing, legal, mental and behavioral health, probation and finances. Attorney, paralegal, notary and legal intern volunteers assisted visitors with resume writing, mock interviews, filling out iob applications, assisting with record expungement and applying for crucial identification-related documents including Social Security cards, birth certificates, driver's license or photo ID. The event was kicked off with poignant speeches by Valerie Arkoosh, chair of the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners, Dean Beers, Montgomery County chief public defender and Edward McCann, first assistant district attorney. They discussed Montgomery County's 59% recidivism rate, the complex challenges and requirements that one faces when reentering, and how all sides of the criminal justice system need to work together to make the reentry process easier and more just. The clinic ran from 1:00-3:00 p.m. and provided lite food and beverages for everyone involved. Visitors were able to move freely among the stations based on their individual needs and without needing to sign up or schedule an appointment in advance. This was a great, impactful event which was well attended and staffed which will hopefully lead to similar clinics in future years.
