YOU'VE BEEN SERVED

Harris Investigations posts ads often about hiring individuals to work with us as private investigators and process servers. Although we may get many applications, in many cases, once they realize what the work entails or that it is not as you see on TV, many turn the job down.

If you were to take the position, often there are no education or licensing requirements. However, one rule in most states is that you must be over 18 with no felonies on your record.

Not all private investigators serve papers, though we recommend you use one instead of just a process server. Why? Laws vary by state, and in most states (including Pennsylvania), individuals must complete a prerequisite training time under another licensed private investigator. Subsequently, you are licensed, bonded, and insured.

In Pennsylvania, only constables have authority and can serve papers from the Magistrate or District Courts. Otherwise, private service requires an appointment.

You've been served!



The situations you must navigate to find and get someone served are not always clear-cut. You can imagine that some people do not want to be located and will go to extremes in avoiding us. Once Harris Investigations receives the paperwork, along with a property search, we check social media to see what the subject looks like. People who do not want to be served will lie about their identity, and having a photo or vehicle information ahead of time is helpful. Most courts require three attempts on a person (one before 8 a.m., one from 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., and one after 6 p.m., with one being a weekend day).

Simply using "You've been served!" and handing someone an envelope is a myth. Technically, when serving a person, you must know what you are serving and inform the recipient without offering legal advice. There are times when you must also read any particular bullet points, such as, "...there is a hearing on August 17 at 9 a.m. You are ordered to appear." Each state has different requirements for proof of service; some require notarized affidavits. In some states, personal service is required for all legal or court documents, while some only need it for custody, adoption, and divorce.
